NAU ASME currently holds biweekly team meetings and takes company tours of local engineering companies, as well as having guest speakers visit NAU during the off weeks.

NAU ASME hopes to compete again in HPVC with a new Human Powered Vehicle (HPV) in spring 2010. In addition to the HPVC, NAU ASME also has a design and plans to build a rickshaw to transport people around NAU's campus and downtown Flagstaff. We also participated in Flagstaff's 10th Annual Northern Lights Holiday Parade in December 2008, and plans to return again in December 2009. We also hope to expand our company tours to statewide.

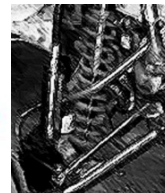


Science Day and around Flagstaff, Arizona. Your company will also be listed on the team's website (nauasme.org).
