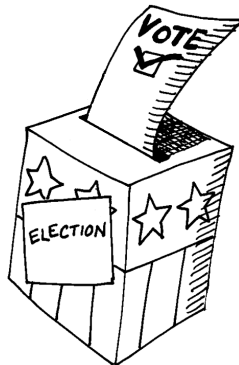

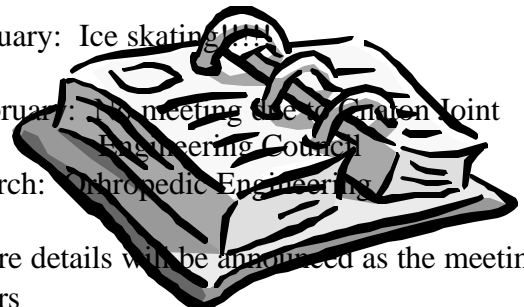

New Dimensions in Multidisciplinary Thinking: Issues, Trends, and Implications for Mechanical Engineers and ASME:

The Committee on Issues Identification has released a new report that focuses on issues and trends that result from the expanded role of multidisciplinary engineers in all sectors of industry and government. It explores the nature of multidisciplinary engineering - where and how it is being employed - and examines its impacts on mechanical engineering practice, education, professional licensure and the research and development environment.

Finally, the report considers the impact of multidisciplinary thinking generally on the field of mechanical engineering, and on ASME International as an organization serving the mechanical engineering profession.
