Kalamazoo Brewing Company

Kalamazoo Brewing Company, founded by Larry Bell as a home-brewing supply shop in 1983, sold its first beer in 1985. Originally brewing in a 15-gallon soup kettle, the company grew rapidly from first year's 135 barrels (BBL = 31 gal.) of production. Kalamazoo Brewing has grown from a tiny operation renting part of a former plumbing supply warehouse, to a bustling, regional craft brewery that plays a role in changing the beerscape of our nation.

A fifty-barrel Steinecker brewhouse drives the new 32,000 square foot brewery, located in Comstock, Michigan. It is complimented by several new fermenters and an integrated bottling hall that includes a new Krones filler. The "Krum Avenue plant" brewed and packaged its first beer in late December, 2002. e-Newsletters Are Here!

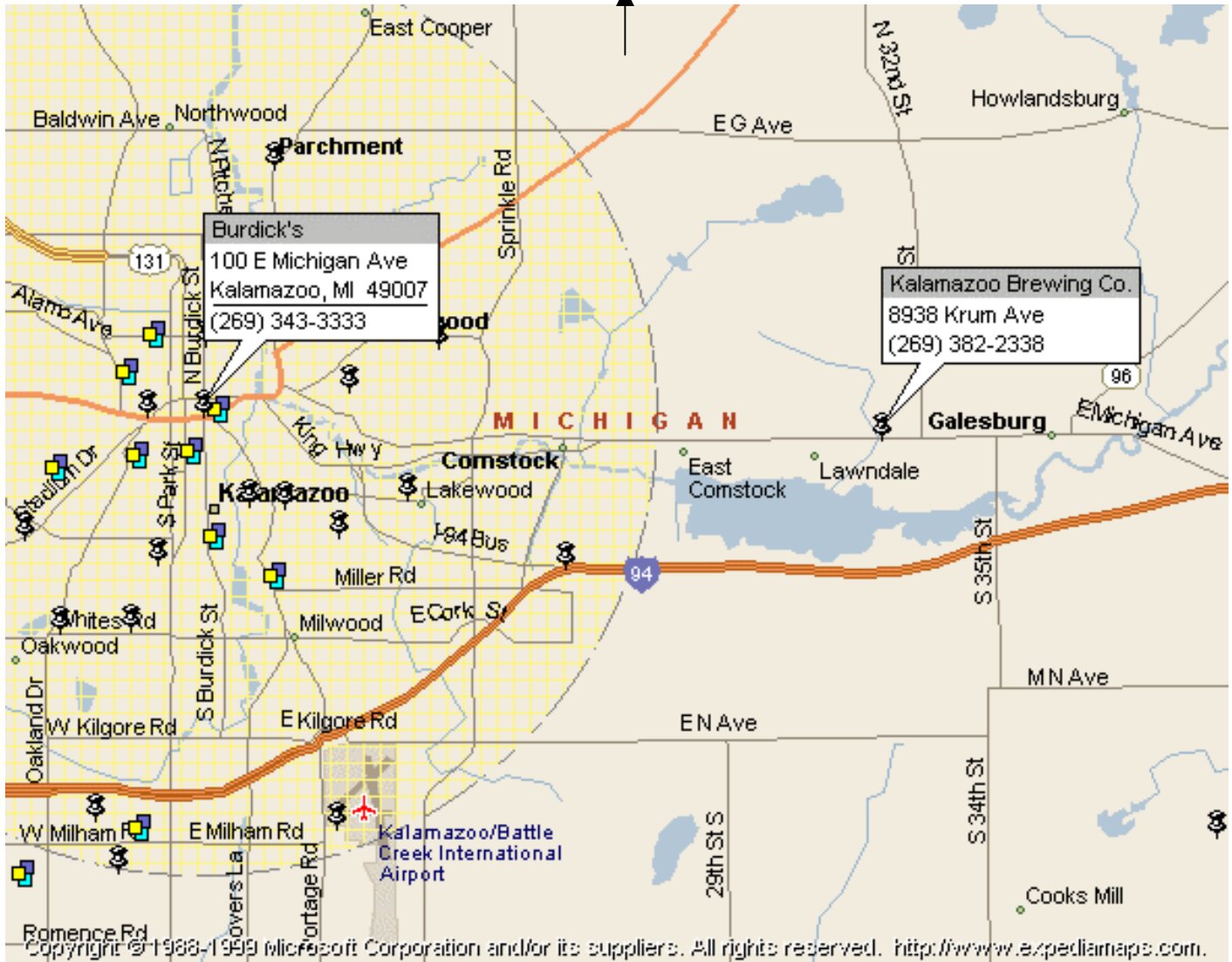

No set up or programming is required on your PC. At this time ASME.ORG does not allow personalization of your ASME.ORG email address. ASME provides this service at no cost to all ASME members.

 - An email address that you can keep for a lifetime
 - No hassle notifying friends, colleagues, etc. whenever your primary email address changes
 - No missed email as long as you remember to update your forwarding email address when there is a change. You can turn forwarding on or off as you desire.
- **SPAM Filter**
 - The ASME mail server has a spam filter that intercepts most of the junk email. Having an ASME email address will not increase your exposure to unwanted messages.



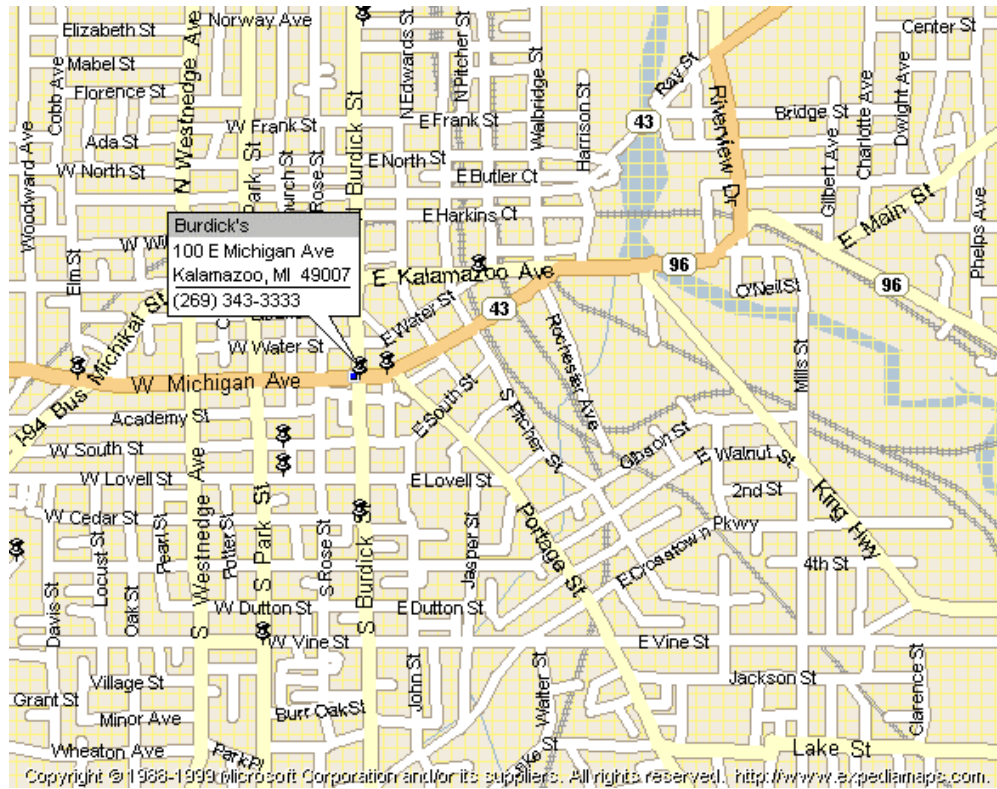
**Kalamazoo-Galesburg area Map
