His past research interests include hepatorenal syndrome, hypertension, and career choice decision factors of medical students.

As a faculty member at the OU College of Medicine, Dr. Andrews

previously held positions as Chief of General Internal Medicine, Associate Dean for Graduate Medical Education, and Senior Associate Dean for Academic Affairs. From 1990 to 1996, at the University Hospital in Oklahoma City, now known as the OU Medical Center, Dr. Andrews served successively as Chief of Staff, Interim Administrator, and Medical Director.

Dr. Andrews has received several distinguished awards for excellence in teaching at the University of Oklahoma and the University of

Tennessee. He has been a member of the Board of Governors of the American College of Physicians, and he is a past chairman and board member of the National Commission on the Certification of Physicians Assistants. In recognition of outstanding contributions throughout his career, the American College of Physicians in 2004 awarded Dr. Andrews the high honor of designation as Master of the American College of Physicians.
