

**Are you interested in assisting a CU Boulder student with his/her career path decisions?
Consider joining our new mentoring program.**

This program will allow students to develop a relationship with a professional, who will help the student answer questions ranging from “What do people in your field look for on a resume?” to “What can I expect the first year on the job?”

In addition to informal discussions between the mentor and mentee, two events will be held to provide ways to make the most of the mentoring relationship. The series of events will provide learning on how to make the most of the mentoring relationship and work/life balance, a hot topic among college students.

Qualifications

To become a mentor, we ask that you 1) have at least two years’ experience, 2) be willing to commit one to two hours of mentoring time per month, and 3) attend two events in Boulder during the year.

- Thursday, November 9th, 2006, 5:00-7:30 PM
- Thursday, April 19th, 2007, 5:00 – 7:30 PM

You and your mentee can choose how you communicate between these events, whether it is over a cup of coffee, a work visit, or primarily email. It is vital you are able to make these time commitments so you and your mentee get the most of your experience.

About the Program

This pilot program will begin the first year with a goal of 60 students and 60 mentors. There is a chance you may not be chosen due to the mentees’ career interests. However, we hope you will be interested the following year if not chosen this year. Additionally, we will advertise extensively to diversity programs to ensure all students are welcome and included in this program.
