Andrew Robbins is Vice President, Business Development & Sales in the Systems Division of Bombardier Transportation. In this role, Mr. Robbins is responsible for the development and sales of all urban rail transit and automated people mover systems in the Americas. This responsibility includes the development of Public-Private Partnership (P3) projects in the region undertaken by Bombardier.

Mr. Robbins has had extensive involvement on international projects. In 2007, Mr. Robbins led Bombardier's efforts to secure a contract for an urban automated transit system in Guangzhou, China. Mr. Robbins also led an international consortium for the development of Singapore's first urban automated people mover system, which has successfully been operating since 1998.

Mr. Robbins has been with Bombardier and predecessor companies for over 29 years. During his career, he has served in various engineering and project management roles for projects worldwide. He has spoken at numerous conferences and public forums, and he holds a U.S. patent related to automated rail transit. He is a registered professional engineer in the States of Pennsylvania and Hawaii. Mr. Robbins holds a B.S.E.E. degree from Lehigh University and an M.S.I.E. degree from the University of Pittsburgh.
