

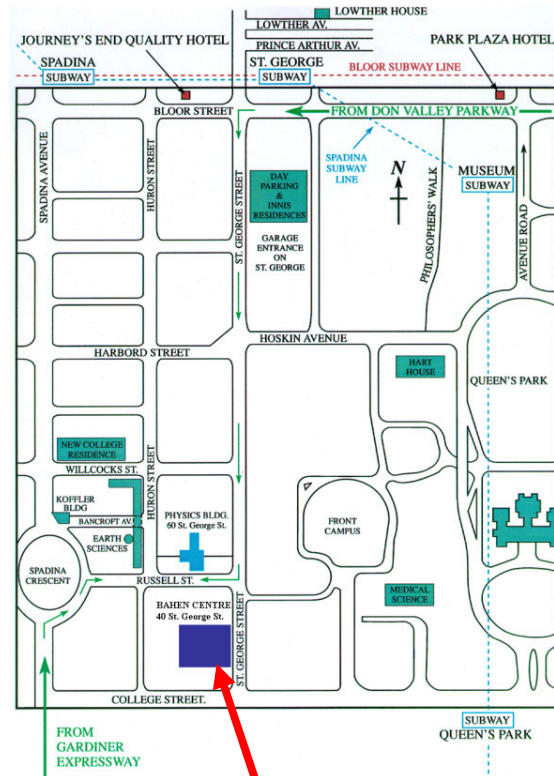
## About ASME...

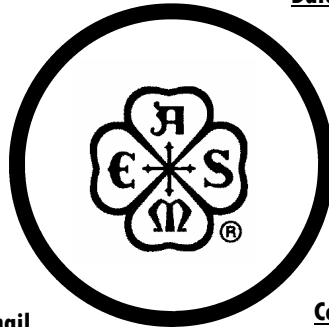
