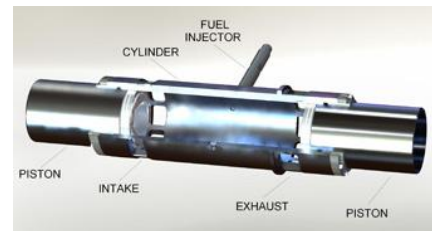


## Tour of Achatés Power

A tour of Achatés (pronounced a-KAY-tees) Power is planned for Wednesday, June 8, 2011, at 3:00 pm. Named after Achatés, Aeneas's faithful friend in Virgil's Latin epic poem "Aeneid," the company was founded in 2004. Its mission is to build fundamentally better engines that enhance fuel economy, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and decrease cost. Its 2-stroke, opposed-piston, compression-ignition engine is key for the future of clean, efficient, and cost-effective passenger- and commercial-vehicle transportation. The company has more than 50 in-house engineers and scientists focused on applying their proven technical know-how and industry expertise, coupled with the industry's leading-edge testing, simulation, and analysis tools.

The company has fully functioning engine prototypes with more than 1,200 test hours, two dynamometers with complete instrumentation to record all necessary engine parameters and test cell conditions, and a fuel lab that rivals those of OEM fuel injector manufacturers and includes laser Doppler anemometry and laser induced fluorescence to characterize fuel spray.
